### **SNAP-NC (Spay/Neuter Assistance Program)**

## About using THE \$20 FIX voucher...

- Please call any veterinarian on the list to make your pet's appointment. (Ask the mobile veterinarians about their locations closest to you.)
- On the phone, let the veterinarian know you will be using a voucher from THE \$20 FIX! Follow all instructions that the veterinarian gives you.
- If one veterinarian cannot accept your pet for an appointment, please call another veterinarian on the list. (Some have limited space.)
- If your pet is too small or too large to meet a mobile veterinarian's weight requirements, please call another veterinarian on the list.
- THE \$20 FIX voucher is valid for 90 days. Please call AnimalKind if you need to request an extension.
- Please be on time for your vet appointment, take cash for the co-pay, and call the veterinarian immediately if you must cancel for any reason.

## About your pet....

- Your female pet can come into her first heat cycle at only 4-5 months old. She can continue to come into heat every few weeks until she is spayed.
- Kittens and puppies can generally be spayed or neutered at the age of 3 months to prevent an unexpected litter. Ask the vet any questions you have about altering your young cat or dog.
- In-heat and pregnant cats and dogs can generally be safely spayed. When you call the vet, ask any questions you have about spaying your in-heat or pregnant female pet.
- If your pet is nursing, allow 6 weeks for the kittens or puppies to be weaned and 1 extra week for them to be separated. Let the vet know that your female has recently had a litter.
